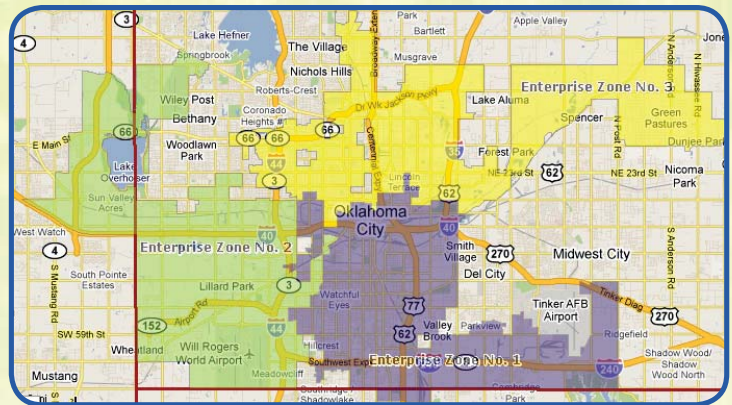

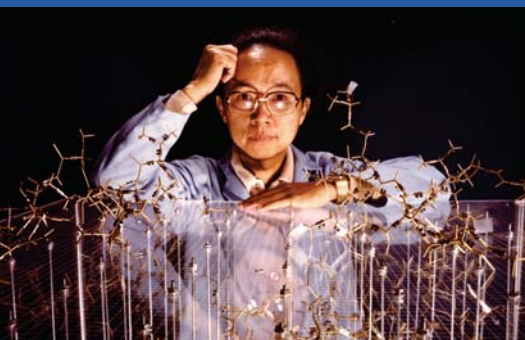
HOW DOES THE SIP INCENTIVE WORK?

Here are a few details of Oklahoma City's new Strategic Investment Program:

- **WAGE THRESHOLDS**
Firms must meet or exceed the OKC MSA's average annual wage, or a minimum of \$33,947 if located in a state-designated Enterprise Zone.
- **CASH PAYMENTS**
Companies are eligible for cash payments for creating jobs in Oklahoma City.
- **NEW PAYROLL**
Companies need to create a minimum net new payroll of \$1.75 million, with at least 50 new employees to be eligible.
- **INSURANCE COVERAGE**
Your company must offer basic health insurance coverage (paying at least 50% of premiums) to workers who are not part-time employees.
